Installation of Your Burner

First find a flat stable surface that is not combustible ensuring that it cannot be knocked over. Install at least 1 Metre away from any combustible objects. Always ensure that nothing can come into contact with the naked flame.

The installation location should be selected in such a way that damage to the product by unauthorised persons can be avoided and so that children and pets cannot have any access to it.

Be Careful!! Filling and Topping up with Gel

Please Read the Warning Label on the Gel Bottle Thoroughly Before Opening

Fill the fuel container up to about 1 cm under the top edge. Ensure that no fuel is spilled. If spillage occurs always remove any fuel first before igniting the burner (use a dry, absorbent, non abrasive cloth). If Gel is spilled on clothing, remove the clothing and launder it immediately. The fuel must not be topped up while it is burning there is a risk of darting flames occurring. Only refill the fuel container when it has cooled down (after approx 30-45 minutes).

Never Smoke While Filling or Topping up with Fuel

Ignite the fuel immediately after pouring into the fuel container to prevent accumulations of combustible gases. Always allow the Gel to burn out completely once lit as the Gel will become un-useable if left for over 24hours.

Lighting the Gel

Place the filled container in the recess provided. Ignite the fuel using a long neck lighter or extra long match and keep it at arms length ensuring sufficient distance of one's head and body from the burner. Keep your face away from the burner.

Observing Your Burner Once Lit

Do not leave the burning fuel unattended. Keep children and pets away from the burner. Do not cover your burner while the fuel is burning.

DO NOT Top up the Fuel Whilst it is Burning – VERY IMPORTANT!!

Never blow on the flame or get the burner wet when in use. Be careful when reaching over the device because clothing or hair could catch fire. These devices will be hot during and after burning: Do not touch or move them until they completely cooled down.

Extinguishing the Flame

To extinguish the flame use the snuffer or lid provided, once the air supply is stopped the flame will go out.

Allow the container to cool down completely before removing it.

It is also advised that the contents of the Gel reservoir should be burnt in full when in use.

Storing Your Gel

Fire Gel (Ethanol) is a highly flammable, keep the Gel stored in its original tightly sealed container and store in a cool, dry place and keep out of reach of children or pets.

IMPORTANT:

Keep away from any sources of heat or ignition during storage and transportation – avoid contact with any parts of the body. These important steps are for your safety and if they are followed correctly you will have many years of enjoyment from the wonderful ambient glow of your Revolution Gel Burner.
