IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT WHILST OPERATING THIS LAMP YOU MUST BE SUPERVISED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT

Installation of Your Lamp

First find a flat stable surface that is not combustible ensuring that it cannot be knocked over. Install at least 1 Metre away from any combustible objects. Always ensure that nothing can come into contact with the naked flame.

The installation location should be selected in such a way that damage to the product by unauthorised persons can be avoided and so that children and pets cannot have any access to it.

Do not use this lamp if there are any signs of damage, and do not modify the lamp in any way.

Be Careful!! Filling and Topping up with Fuel

Please Read the Warning Label on the Fuel Bottle Thoroughly Before Opening

Fill the fuel container and ensure that no fuel is spilled. If spillage occurs always remove any fuel first before igniting the wick (use a dry, absorbent, non abrasive cloth). If fuel is spilled on clothing, remove the clothing and launder it immediately.

Only refill the fuel container when it has cooled down (after approx 30-45 minutes). Burning time is approx 2 hours.

Never Smoke While Filling or Topping up with Fuel

Lighting the Lamp

Place the filled container in the recess provided. Allow the fuel to soak up the wick for approx 15 minutes before lighting.

Ignite the fuel using a long neck lighter or extra long match and keep it at arms length ensuring sufficient distance of one's head and body from the lamp while fuel is burning.

Observing Your Lamp Once Lit

Do not leave the burning fuel unattended. Check to see if the fuel is present or not, you must empty the container before each re-fill.

Keep children and pets away from the burner. Do not cover your lamp while the fuel is burning.

These devices will be hot during and after burning.

Extinguishing the Flame

To extinguish the flame use the snuffer provided, once the air supply is stopped the flame will go out.

Allow the container to cool down completely before removing it.

It is also advised that the contents of the reservoir should be burnt in full when in use.

Storing Your Fuel

Keep the fuel stored in its original tightly sealed container and store in a cool, dry place and keep out of reach of children or pets.
